**Notes:**

You need to complete all your planning within the daily routine.

On very busy/disruptive days (e.g. photo day), it isn't a train smash if you don't get to everything on your planning and the daily routine doesn't go as planned. Just try to stick to it as closely as possible. However, it cannot become a habit.

There is room for a bit of freedom. If you feel you would like to do your story/singing etc at a different time that is ok- as long as you fit everything into your day. If you finish up something before the allocated time you can slot in story time, music & drama, free outside play etc.

The chn MUST get outdoor time at least once in the morning.

The group that is inside doing the art activities must be split up further. This is where you will have your 4 activities/tables set up. The chn inside will rotate around them. Please make sure everyone goes to each activity. Don't let 1 child stay at one activity the whole time. These exact same activities must be set up for both groups – all the chn must do the same thing on each day.

While you have freedom to choose what creative activities you do each morning, the following have to be done:

**Play dough:** at least once a week.

**Cutting:** once a week. (teachers may cut out small items, as long as the chn have cut once in the week.)

**Construction of some sort** (box, on flat cardboard, construction game/blocks): at least once a week.

**Fantasy play** (dress up clothes, pots & pans, stove, dolls etc): at least once a week.

Please refer to your 'Weekly Requirements' list to ensure that you do everything else that is required.
